

## **EFUDEX**

Wait until the skin on the scalp/area to treated has fully healed (i.e.: no scabs from a biopsy, no blisters from liquid-nitrogen treatment) to begin the Efudex treatment – approximately 3 weeks.

### EFUDEX PROTOCOL:

1. Start applying cream daily **UNTIL ONE OF TWO THINGS HAPPENS:**
    - a. A severe reaction occurs (i.e.: blistering) – if this happens, stop Efudex application.
- OR**
- b. You have applied Efudex daily for four weeks straight.

**\* At this point, your treatment is complete. \***

This cream is applied to skin that has been severely sun-damaged, and is used as a therapy to treat multiple dormant skin-cancers at once. The blistering reaction is a sign of pre-cancers and is anticipated and to be expected. If a blistering reaction occurs, proceed with the following aftercare:

1. Wash with soap and warm water or a saline rinse
2. Gently pat dry with a clean towel
3. Apply a small amount of ointment (Fucidin, Aquaphor, Vaseline or Polysporin)

**\*\*Avoid application around/near eyes**
